


Day: 2/ Cup B	I checked on cup B but just like cup A, there were no sprouts. The soil was very dry like the previous day so I watered it with the 6 ml. I placed the cup back in the sun on the window sill.	x	X
Day: 3/ Cup A	There was still no growth from the seeds. I could still see the seeds on top of the soil. I watered with 6 ml of water to moisten the soil. I set the cup back on the window sill and refilled the water cup.	x	V
Day: 3/ Cup B	I still do not see sprouts. I wetend the soil with 6 ml of water again. I placed the cup back on the window sill. Hopefully over the weekend the seeds will germinate.	x	X
Day: 4/ Cup A	I am pleased to report that one of my seeds has germinated. A sprout has come up and out of the seed shell. It is still attached to the seed shell and it's root is curved down to plant in the soil. The root is white with a very light green towards the shell. It is too small to measure. The soil was dry so I watered again.	-	
Day: 4/ Cup B	I have 3 sprouts coming up from the soil. The middle one has a red stem near the base which turns into green up towards the leaves. The leaves are bright green. The 2 leaves are touching each other but are about to spread apart. The second sprout is completely green and the 2 leaves have fully separated. The last sprout is pale yellow at the bottom of the stem. The leaves are light green and are still together. I watered the plants and set the cup back on the sill.	3.8cm 3cm -
