

## Searching For eBooks at the SMSU Library

This is a quick help sheet for finding electronic and print books.

Using a balance of resources, periodicals, newspapers, and books is critical to conducting a college research project. Books provide you with a breadth and depth of understanding. The SMSU Library Online Portal is an easy way to find electronic books. This sheet will explain how to access ebooks step-by-step.

It is important for you to know that using eBooks is quick and convenient, and provides excellent, up-to-date resources. Using eBook text is simple; you can copy and paste directly from the eBook to create resource notecards and direct quotes in your essays. Soon, you will be able to download eBooks to your computer through the university library database.

For a simple search, enter subject terms 'capital punishment' and 'Texas'. Remember that you must use the word 'and' between the search terms. Capital punishment is one search term comprised of two words.
