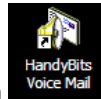




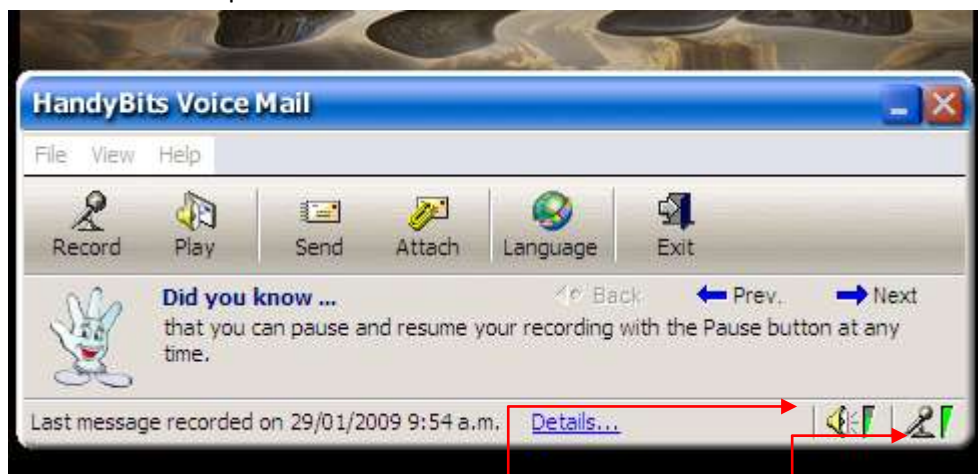
HandyBits Voice Mail

You can create a voice mail instead of a traditional text mail. The main idea when developing Voice Mail, was the creation of a tool for those who feel that it is easier to record a voice message than to type a traditional message. Simply click the Record button, talk, and then click the Stop and Send buttons. That's it. A great feature of this cool tool is the very high compression (GSM) of your voice mail. This reduces both the size as well as the transmitting time of the e-mail message up to 10 times.

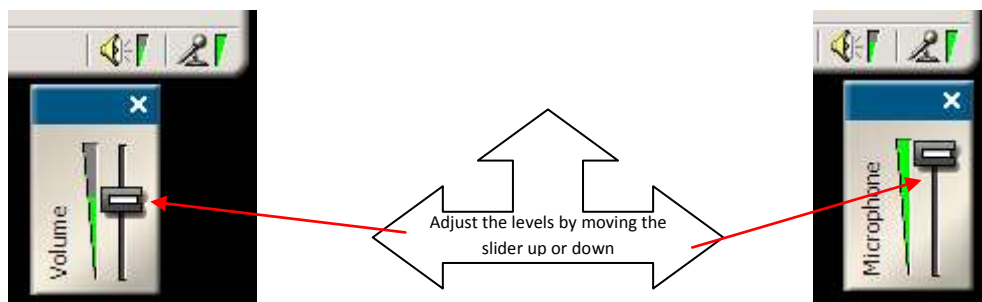
Get started in 10 easy steps:



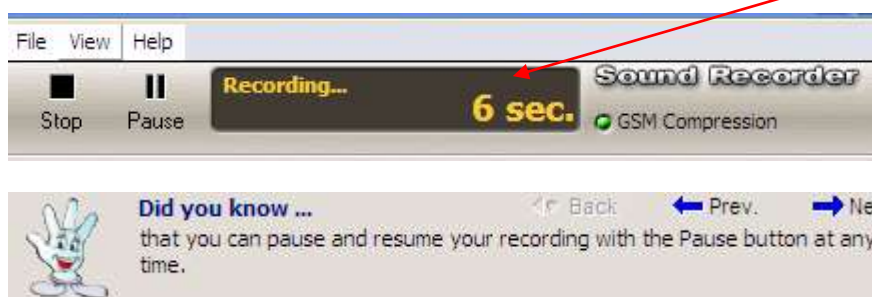
1. Click on this icon on your desktop or find it in your programs menu.
2. This window will open.



3. Note that the volume and microphone levels can be adjusted.

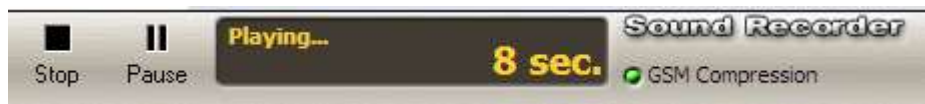

5. Click on the **Record** menu button to start recording. A new screen will appear showing the length of the recording.

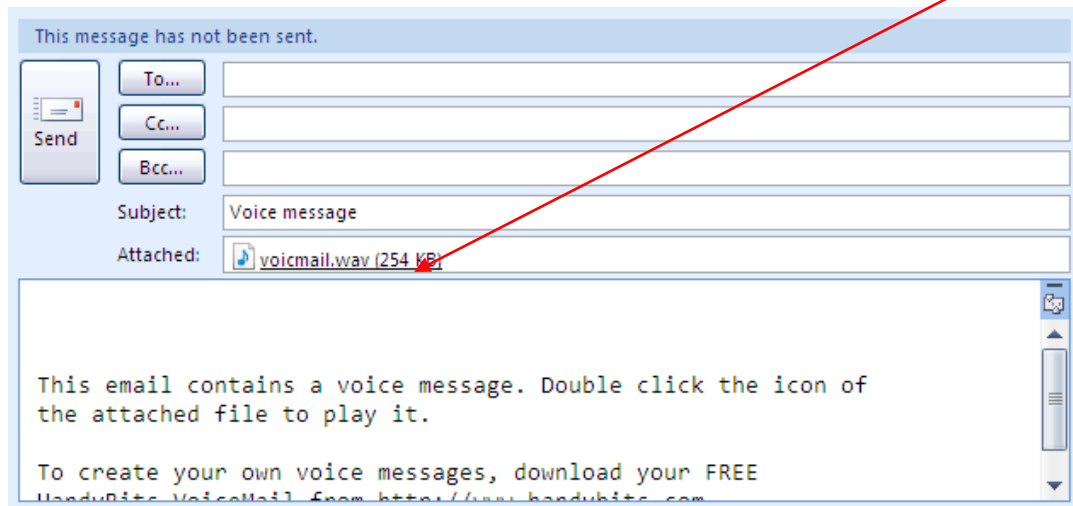

7. To listen to your recording, click on the **Play** button



8. Once satisfied with your recording, you are now ready to send it as voicemail using MSOutlook.
9. Click on the **Send** button. A new message window will open in MSOutlook with the sound file already attached.



10. Remember to type in the address of the message recipient and **Send**.

Other features:

- You may attach the sound file to an existing e-mail message by dragging and dropping the



icon into the body of an e-mail.

- You can change the language setting by clicking on the **Language** button.
