- Student-safe email that filters for messages that don't belong at school

- Monitored web publishing like "blogs" and "wikis" where students post electronic work online. Teachers will have control to limit access to these web sites or open them up to involve interesting and exciting "guest visitors" over the Internet

With your permission, the district will make an account for your student to use with class. All students must follow the Student Code of Conduct just like any technology used at school.
