Due Wednesday, March 26, 2014, to Office 2, by 3:30 p.m.

****Your presentation of this application is VERY important! Submit a typed resume that includes ALL of the following information. You can write in narrative, or use bullets. At least one letter of recommendation from an educator, coach, employer etc., is required, submit more if you have them. You may also want to attach copies of awards that you have received while in high school. Personal statements are optional, but recommended, and give you a chance to tell about your goals, life history, and anything else you think is important for people to know about you. Be sure to carefully proofread your application. *Please do not staple your application.***

Heading with your name and contact information

Personal/Background Information:

- Colleges and/or technical schools that have accepted you, and where you are planning to attend school next year.
- Objective: Career goals, college major, course of study you are pursuing, and what interests you about that career or course of study.
- Complete list of extra-curricular activities in which you have participated (Clubs, Sports, ASB/Leadership, Band, Choir, Drama, Aca-Deca etc.).
- Complete list of community activities/service in which you have participated.
- Employment history: include employer's name/address and your responsibilities.
- List of awards and achievements and dates you received them.

Personal Financial Information:

- Include a statement about your financial need to attend school.
- Number of family members dependent upon the family income.
- Any special circumstances regarding your financial situation, including self-supporting, in foster care, single parent family, first generation college student etc.
- Your plans for financing your education, including any additional assistance.
- Outline an estimate of your costs, including room, board, books, tuition, transportation and miscellaneous expenses.

Transcript:

- Get an official transcript from Sue in Office 2 and attach it to your resume.
