Group #1 “Information Team”

-Your group is responsible for finding information related to World War 1, such as the dates of which events occurred, who was leading who, where the events were happening, etc. Your group has the biggest responsibility of them all, as being thorough, precise, and accurate are of utmost importance! A **two** page typed summary of your timeline events is required. You are also in charge of creating the timeline of events, so you will have the opportunity to be creative and map out what you have learned!

Group #2 “Pictorial Border Team”

-Your group is responsible for finding old authentic newspaper/magazine articles about World War 1. Most of your time will be spent in the library. You are also responsible for finding pictures that relate to the war, using the Internet, magazines, etc. Once your pictures are gathered together, you will make a border out of them, so as you can see, you will need to gather MANY of them! The last thing your team is responsible for is to provide a 2-page typed summary of who your pictures are of and the importance of each picture.

Group #3 “Background Team”

-Your group is responsible for creating the background of the timeline, as you would in a mural. Be very detailed, creative, and colorful! Examples can include drawing a world map, leaders, etc. or whatever you want to do. You may want to talk with group #2 about their ideas! Finally, your group needs to provide a **two** page typed summary of what your background is about. You may want to include such things as, important battles and the significance of them.

***You will all be given in-class time to work on your timelines, but as you know, time is very limited here. So, keep the communication lines within your group open and plan to work outside of school time to get things done. You will have today, and Wednesday - Friday next week (other than our quiz) in class to work. We will present them in class on Monday, Nov. 14.**

Points/Grade

Since you will be working in groups, your grade will depend upon the people in your group. At the end of this project, you will all receive a private grading sheet where you will each decide what the others in your group will receive for points. If you contributed largely to your group, you will obviously receive a good grade. If you contributed little to your group, the other members will not grade you so well. Work together and contribute fairly, or your group may not be so nice! ☺ Other points will be gathered for neatness, content, accuracy, organization, creativity, etc. for a total of 70 points (this is an ASSESSMENT)
