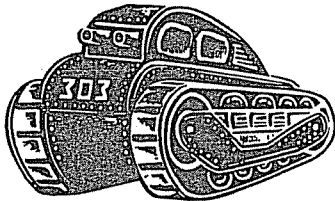
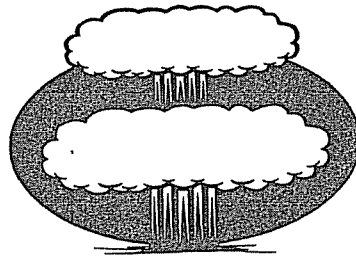


World War II

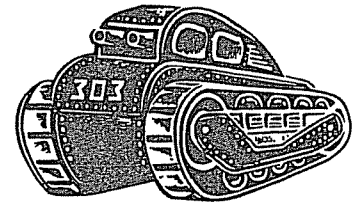

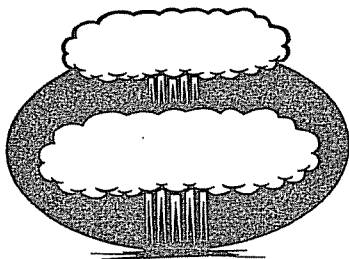
Comprehension: Give examples of ways in which women helped the war effort.



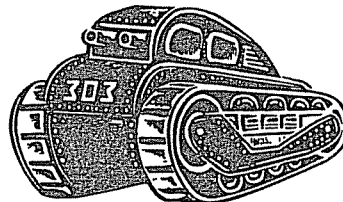
Application: Interview a family friend or relative who served during World War II. If possible, examine photographs taken during that time period. Prepare a written report of your meeting.
