

Angle - also known as *perspective*

Following are some common angles for taking pictures:

1. birds-eye view
2. bugs-eye view
3. eye-level
4. close-up
5. full-view
6. profile/side view

You must take as many as possible *unique* angles of a:

1. **flower or ground plant**
2. **classmate ***
3. **child ***
4. **vehicle ***
5. **tree**
6. **the school**
7. **inanimate object ***
8. **your choice :)**

JH – Choose the 4 * items. You must have at least 4 angles of each subject for a total of 16 good images. You may do more subjects from the list for XC.

Import the photos into iPhoto, put them in a folder titled **Angle, and title them as shown below:**

- *flower bird, flower bug, flower close, flower full* (eye-level and profile would be duplicates of other views)
- *Joe bird, Joe bug, Joe eye, Joe close, Joe full, Joe profile*

HS should have an album of around 40 good images.

JH must have at least 16 good images.

HS Print a contact sheet with ALL the angles of 4 different subjects. You should have 20-24 pictures. Print this as a two-sided 3 column contact sheet with titles that describe the image and angle.

JH– Print a contact sheet with all your angles of 2 different subjects.

Grading

album - 1 pt per angle (*HS* over 40 is XC, *JH* over 16 is XC)

contact sheet- 1 pt per *good* image (*HS* over 22 is XC, *JH* over 10 is XC)

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
