


# **Contact Sheet** for **Common Errors**

## create an album titled **Common Errors**

- place your *common error* images in this album (drag them to the album)



- click the *i* (for info) button. You'll see the name of the photo.




- change the name of the photo to match the description (blurry, crisp, red-eye...)

To fix exposure go to  
***edit*** and ***enhance***.  
Don't worry about fixing it  
more than that for now.  
For red-eye choose ***Red-Eye***  
and click in the middle of the eye.



drag your photos to match the order  
of the assignment

- blurry, crisp
- red-eye, red-eye corrected
- background distraction, no distraction
- overzoomed
- over exp, overexp fixed
- underexp, underexp fixed




select all the photos in your album  
(**command-a**)

select Print or go to File > Print  
(**command-p**)

choose the 2nd option  
(contact sheet)


**DO NOT PRINT YET!**




choose **Customize**  
and make sure it's set to **3**  
**columns there should be**  
**2 pages, just like this**  
**image.**

Click on  
Settings and make sure  
**Titles** is  
checked.

Choose **Print**  
and...



make sure it says **Room 608 HP....**  
Click the blue triangle to show your  
options and make sure  
two-sided is selected!
