



Elementary integrated Technology Lesson Plan

Subject Area: Language Arts - Word Families, Ending Sounds and Spelling three letter words

Curriculum Specifics:

- [CCSS.ELA-Literacy.RF.K.2c](#) Blend and segment onsets and rimes of single-syllable spoken words.
- [CCSS.ELA-Literacy.RF.K.2d](#) Isolate and pronounce the initial, medial vowel, and final sounds (phonemes) in three-phoneme (consonant-vowel-consonant, or CVC) words.¹ (This does not include CVCs ending with /l/, /r/, or /x/.)
- [CCSS.ELA-Literacy.RF.K.2e](#) Add or substitute individual sounds (phonemes) in simple, one-syllable words to make new words.

Lesson Objectives: Students will work on word families associations, finding ending consonant letter sounds and practice short three letter word spelling.

Materials/Resources Needed: iPad, Pocket Pro App

Lesson: Students will open the Pocket Pro App and first select the word Families icon. They will do the lessons their at least ten times. They then proceed to the ending letter sound icon and again practice for ten times. Finally they will complete the lesson by choosing the Spelling 3 Letter Words. If students finish these they may choose another icon to complete.
