Packing List

- ONE CHECK BAG (MAXIMUM)

- One pair of work shoes (tennis shoes work well, no open toed shoes or sandals of any kind)
- 5 pairs of work gloves (get the cheap kind from the local grocery store as they will

probably only last one day for each pair.)

- Hat (something that projects you face and neck from the sun)

Indonesia wear

- 5 shirts (must cover shoulders and must not have a low neck line)
- 2 pairs of pants/shorts (must cover below the knee)
- swim suit (something KIS appropriate also bring a shirt you can get wet to complete your suit)
- Towel
- comfortable shoes (walking shoes)
- 3 to 4 pairs of socks
- sandals (optional)
- clothing for donation to the local people (any and all items will be accepted)

Medical / hygiene
