

Importing Video Clips into iMovie '09

1. Connect your Flip Camera to the computer by plugging it into one of the USB ports on your computer.
2. Once the computer recognizes the camera is attached, it will open an import window. *See Connecting to a Flip Camera if you have problems with the importing of your video clips.*
3. Posters of your video clips will be displayed in the lower half of the screen.
4. Options:
 - a. Automatic Import: imports all of the video clips in the camera.
 - b. Manual Import: select only those video clips you want for your project.
 - c. For our workshop, select Automatic to import all the videos.
5. We are creating a **New Project**, so we need to create a **New Event** for our **New Project**. Click the button for **Create a New Event**.
6. Give the Event a name by typing a logical name for your video in the box.
7. Leave the check box checked for split days into new Events.
8. DO NOT check the box for stabilization after import.
9. Click **Import**.
10. Watch the status bars at the bottom of each movie.
11. A notice of success will appear when the import is complete.
12. Click the OK button.
13. Your import will appear in the Event Library at the lower left side of the iMovie window.
