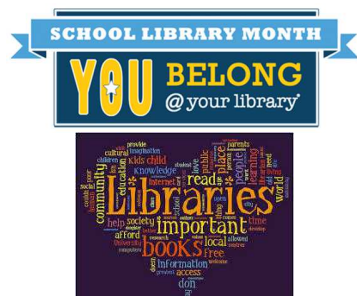

as you can see.

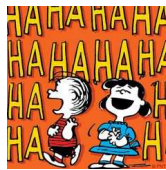

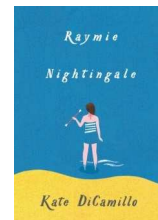
