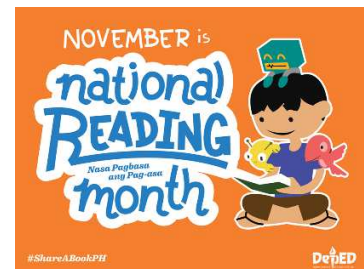

### **AUTHOR VISIT**

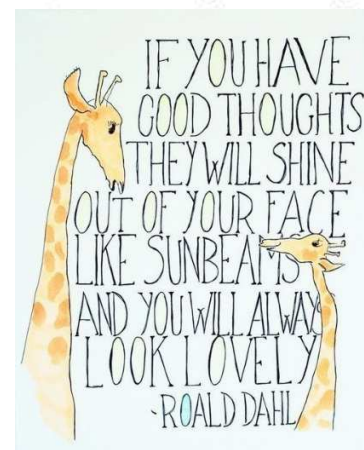
