3. A two-page written summary of your follow-up work, based on the questions below:
 - 1) Please describe the new information and teaching strategies you gained from this seminar, and how you will incorporate or have incorporated them into your curriculum. *(At least 1 type-written page)*
 - a. Learning goals for your students
 - b. Resources that are needed
 - c. Summary of your lesson plan and information that you use for them.
 - 2) Please choose 1 – 3 resources from the "Bibliography & Suggested Resources for Teachers" handout you received in this seminar. Write a review, including how and why you would use this particular resource in your classroom. *(At least 1 type-written page)*
