Letter: Imagine that you had the chance to meet anyone in the world. Write a letter to your teacher explaining the reasons why you would like to meet that person.	Rubric: Create a detailed rubric for public speaking.	Writing: Write one to two paragraphs about something you recently learned that made you think. Explain what you learned and why it was important.
Flyer: Using an illustration, create a visual aid that could be used to support your speech topic. Provide a brief explanation of how your poster could have been used as a support for your most recent (or upcoming) speech.	Writing: Select two animals. Write one to two paragraphs comparing and contrasting these animals.	Powerpoint: Create a powerpoint comparing and contrasting two different characters from your favorite book or movie.
Graph or diagram: Create a graph or diagram that could be used as a visual aid for one of your speeches. Provide a brief explanation of how this visual aid would be used to support your speech.	Brochure: Pick a vacation destination that you have been to or would like to visit. Create a brochure describing this destination in detail.	Script: Think of one of your favorite TV shows. Develop a script for a future episode that would include a guest appearance by you.

Whenever you finish the task at hand, you are to select one of these to work on. These will be graded using the rubric on the back. Remember, this is a great way to improve your grade as these are entered as an extra assignment!
