


HOW TO Access SIRS Discoverer using Galileo

SIRS Discoverer is a internet based database of 1600 newspaper, magazine, and government document articles chosen for educational content.
Why use it? Information found on *SIRS Discoverer* is reliable and authoritative.

1. Use the RMS library website, www.renfroelibrary.org
2. Select Reference Resources and go to Galileo.



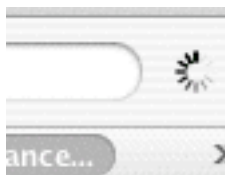
3. Log in to Galileo and choose  K-12
4. On the middle school list, select #11 *SIRS Discoverer*
5. Browse the subject tree, selecting a broad topic that interests you.



After choosing a broad topic, look for the list of related topics on the right.

Helpful hints when using Galileo:

Give Galileo time to access data—don't keep clicking while waiting! In Firefox, wait for this wheel to stop spinning before clicking again!



Galileo may be accessed at school without a password
At home, you will need this password: courage (valid through 3-24-08)
