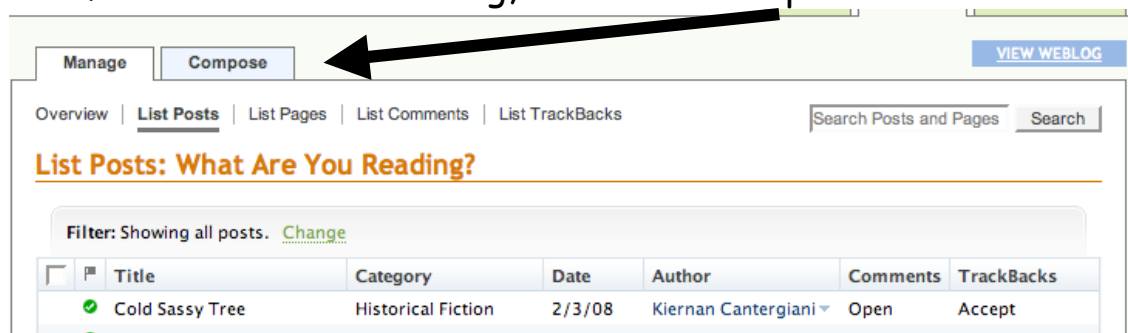


Part 3: Adding a book to the blog

1. Check the posts to see if your book is already on the blog. If so, move to part 4 of the how-to.
2. If book is not on the blog, select the compose tab.



3. Include all of the following information in your blog post.
