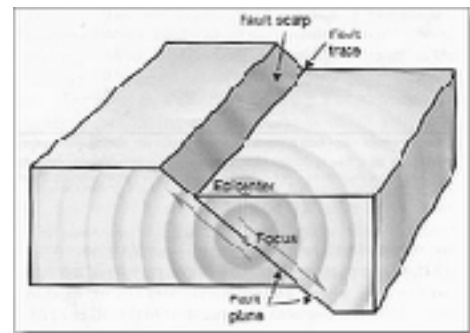


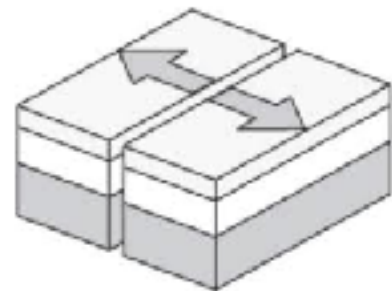
Plate Boundaries: The edges of different pieces of the lithosphere meet at lines called plates



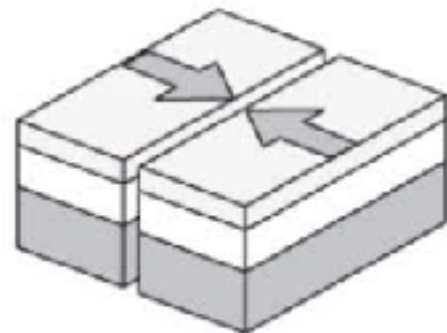
Faults – breaks in the Earth's crust where rocks have slipped past each other – form along these boundaries.



Divergent Boundary: The place where two plates move apart, or diverge, is called a divergent boundary.



Convergent Boundary: The place where two plates come together, or converge, is a convergent boundary.



Transform Boundary: A transform boundary is a place where two plates slip past each other, moving in opposite
