It is important for you to reflect on what you did during the experiment and why it was important in relation to the real-world. Be sure to set up your page as a type three: skip lines, write your FCA's in the top left corner. Remember to write your name in the top right with the date under it.

FCA's:

- 1) Choose one lab activity we did this week and describe how it relates to your notes. Be sure to be descriptive and specific. Give examples and details.
Points: 20
- 2) Describe a real-world example of this experiment and justify why your example makes this lab valid.
Points: 20
- 3) Use complete thoughts and sentences with legible hand writing.
Points: 10

When you are finished writing this lab out, re-read the lab and edit it for any mistakes or errors that you find. Be sure to answer the following questions:

- Did I complete the assignment?
- Does the composition sound right? Is it easy to read?
- Do I have problems with the focus correction areas?
