

Producer: An organism that can make its own food is a producer.



Consumer: An organism that obtains energy by feeding on other organisms is a consumer.



Herbivore: Consumers that eat only plants are called herbivores.



Carnivore:
Consumers that eat only animals are called carnivores.



Omnivore: Consumers that eat both animals and plants is called an omnivore.



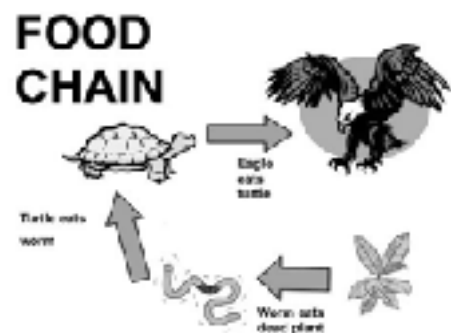
Scavenger: A scavenger is a carnivore that feeds on the bodies of dead organisms.



Decomposer: Organisms that break down wastes and dead organisms and return the raw materials to the environment are called decomposers.



Food Chain: A food chain is a series of events in which one organism eats another and obtains energy.



Food Web: A food web consists of many overlapping food chains in an ecosystem.



Energy Pyramid: A diagram called an energy pyramid shows the amount of energy that moves from one feeding level to another in a food web.
