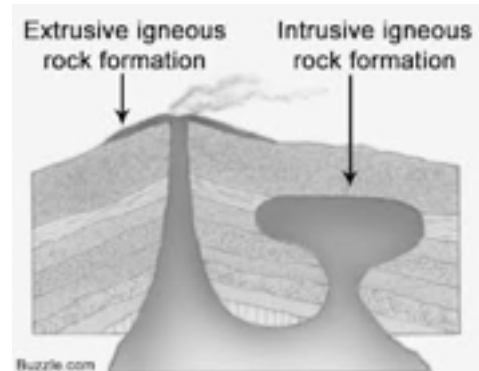


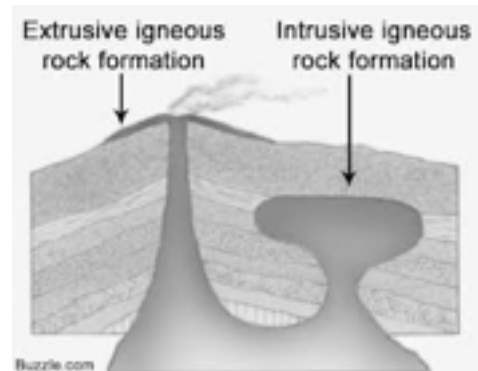
Igneous rock: Any rock that forms from magma or lava.



Extrusive rock:  
Igneous rock formed from lava that erupted onto Earth's surface.
