

LESSON 2

Activation:	Upon entering the media center we will have a brief lecture and discussion about the research method and correctly citing works.
Direct instruction:	Instructors will review the AGOPPE process of research: Ask Questions, Gather Information, Organize Information, Prepare and Produce, Present Information, Evaluate the Process. Instructors will review using NoodleTools to correctly cite work, and using a Creative Commons search for appropriate reproduction of material on the web.
Modeling and guided practice:	Building on the concept map created in the prior lesson, we will ask some central questions about one of the topics. Including: What do I know? What do I need to know? Where can I find this information? Working on the Promethean board, we will use the online databases to search for information, save it in NoodleTools .
Independent practice:	Students will go to online databases and begin research on their topic of choice while the LMS and Health Teacher circulate to redirect and assist. This will also provide an opportunity to formatively assess the students understanding of their topic and the research method.
Sharing and reflecting:	At the end of the class, we will regroup to revisit AGOPPE , answer questions and remind students to continue their research. They should come up with two resources between now and the next class.
