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- To provide opportunities for academic enrichment, including providing tutorial services to help children, particularly students who attend low-performing schools, and meet State and local student academic achievement standards in core academic subjects, such as reading, mathematics, and science.
- To provide academic activities for students, aligned with the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) and Texas Assessment of Knowledge and Skills (TAKS). This includes a broad array of services, programs and activities, designed to reinforce and complement the regular school day academic program.
- To provide students enrichment programs and activities, such as youth development activities, drug and violence prevention programs, counseling programs, art, music, physical education/fitness programs, and technology education programs that are designed to reinforce and complement the regular academic program.

Learning Beyond the Bell (LBB) is a free after-school program in 5 high needs schools within Lewisville ISD

Mission: To offer a free, safe, enriching and supervised environment for Lewisville ISD students in grades 3-5, in which students develop academic competency and confidence, higher-level thinking skills and problem-solving, creativity, individual growth through hands-on experiences, peer interaction and positive adult relationships.

Purpose: To provide after-school learning opportunities beyond the regular school day. The program focuses on helping children in high-need schools succeed academically through the use of scientifically-based extended learning time. LBB is a powerful program that enhances and complements the regular school day, rather than duplicating or imitating classroom instruction.
