Converting Video Files to .mp4



Jodix is a free third-party file conversion software that takes Windows Media Player files (.wmv) and converts them to MPEG 4 files for video podcasting.

1. Open your browser and go to <http://snapfiles.com/get/jodixipodvideo.html>
2. Download a copy of Jodix iPod Video Converter.
3. Once on Jodix iPod Video Converter is downloaded, install the program.

Converting files with Jodix

1. Open Jodix.
2. Click **Add Files**
3. Locate your file and click **Open**
 - The settings screen appears. This gives some basic info about the file
4. Click **Next**
5. Select 320 X 240 (which is recommended) from the video size drop down menu.
6. Select the options to increase the video and/or audio quality.
 - **Note:** As you increase the quality of the audio and video, the size of the file will also increase. The output file information determines the size of the file.
7. Click **Next**
 - The create tags screen appears.
8. Enter a title for your video by filling in the Author, Genre, or Copyright information.
9. Click **OK** (*Your files should show up in the task list section.*)
10. Click **Convert**
 - A successful message appears if your files have been converted successfully.
11. Open iTunes and import your video.

Converting Video from Teacher Tube

1. Sign into teachertube.com
2. Find a video.
3. Click the link to download the video to your desktop (it will end with .flv).
4. Go to media-convert.com.
5. Click browse and locate the .flv file.
6. Select "IPOD MP4 Video" for Output.
7. Click the Accept box.
8. Click Convert button.
9. Wait.
10. Click the Download button.
11. Select Movies in iTunes source panel.
12. Drag and drop video from desktop into iTunes.

Converting Video from YouTube

1. Find a video and copy the URL for the video.
2. Go to www.vixy.net (*Zamzar and Movavi also work*)
3. Paste the URL and Select MP4.
4. Click **Start** then **Wait**
5. Download the .mp4 file.
6. Select Movies in iTunes source panel.
7. Drag and drop video from desktop into iTunes.
