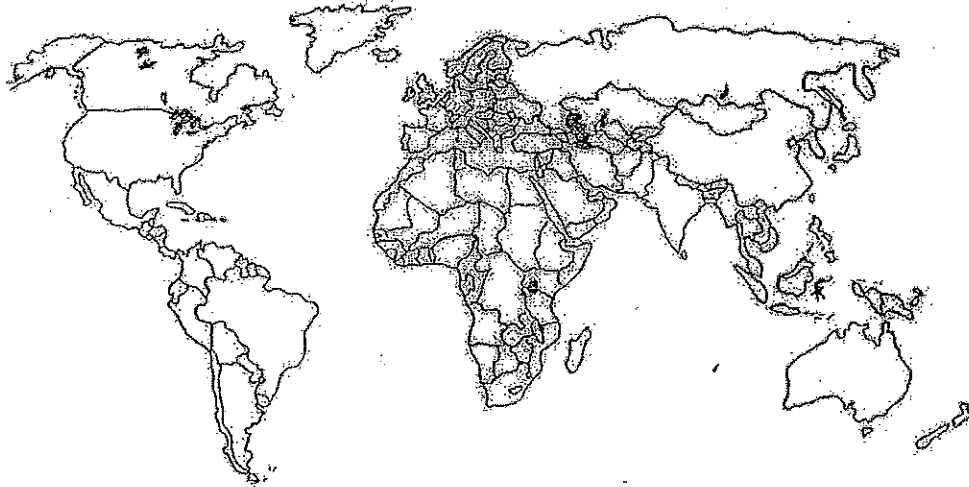


GEOGRAPHY:
