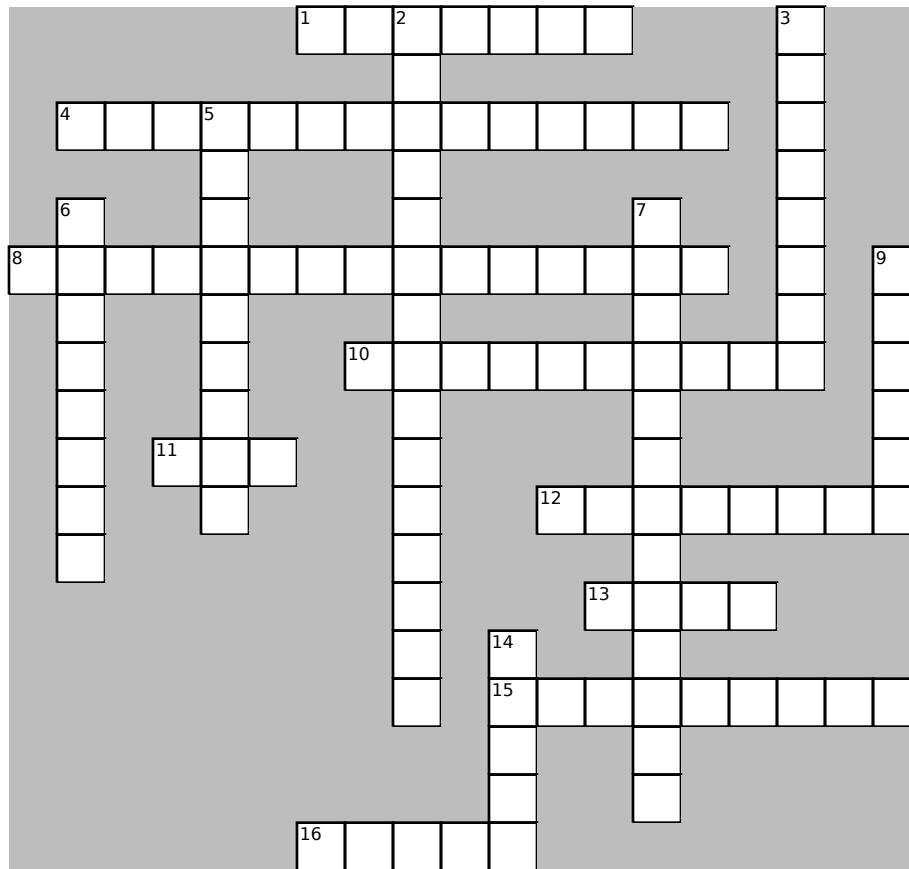


Drama/Poetry Terminology

- 1 Descriptive language that appeals to the senses
- 4 2 consecutive lines that rhyme (2 Words)
- 8 Giving human qualities to non-human things
- 10 Unrhymed poetry with regular rhythm spoken by most characters in play (2 Words)
- 11 Joke based on word with several meanings or on words that sound alike
- 12 Conversation between 2+ characters
- 13 Character who is opposite of another character; emphasizes traits of both
- 15 Long speech by 1 character directed to at least 1 other character
- 16 Sentences, not poetry, spoken by servants

Down

- 2 Words that are no longer in common use today (2 Words)
- 3 Speech at the beginning to comment on the events in the play
- 5 Long speech spoken by a character who is (presumably) alone on stage
- 6 Comparison of 2 unlike things; no like or as
- 7 Hints or clues of what will occur later
- 9 Comparison of two unlike things; uses like or as
- 14 A brief comment by a character that is heard by audience, not other characters
