- Make sure you get plenty of sleep tonight...the day will be packed with excitement!
- Be at the school, in our classroom NO LATER than 6:30. Please do your teachers a HUGE favor by not arriving too early either!
- You may take one backpack on the bus. Everything you bring MUST fit easily in your backpack. Teachers and parent chaperones WILL NOT be responsible for your backpack or its contents!
- You may bring appropriate books, magazines, cards, etc. If you are not sure whether or not your item is appropriate, DO NOT BRING IT!
- You may pack a nutritious snack in your backpack (not packed with your lunch). If you bring a drink for the bus it must be CLEAR LIQUID with a TWIST OFF CAP.
- You must bring a lunch packed in a one-gallon Ziploc bag (with your name on it) so that we can dispose of everything and keep things dry in the cooler.
- Wear comfortable shoes and clothes. We will be on the bus A LOT and walking around A LOT!
- Don't forget to bring your sack lunch-completely disposable-in a gallon Ziploc bag with your name on it! Remember to pack something to drink with your lunch.
- You may bring electronics with you for the bus, but remember to think carefully about your choice. Ask yourself the following questions to help you decide:
 - Have my parents given me permission to bring it?
 - Will it fit into my backpack (along with everything else I'm bringing)?
 - If it makes noise, do I have headphones or am I willing to do without the sound?
 - If something were to happen to it, can I live without it?
 - Will it invade the privacy/personal space of others?
 - Is it worth bringing? How much will I really use it?
- Bring a camera if you want to take pictures. There are lots of great photo opportunities!
