### Recently Added: Lexile® Measurements, Ratings on All Resources, and Alignments to the New Common Core ELA Standards

Do you know about the recent enhancements to our service, all added to help support your use and value of TeachingBooks?

**Lexile®:** Identify titles that correspond to a desired reading level range on our Guided/Advanced Search (<http://TeachingBooks.net/AdvancedSearch>). *Note: We’ve programmed this to yield results only if a grade level is marked with the reading level.*

**Ratings:** Rank the resources you use on TeachingBooks with up to five stars, and use ratings to help distinguish materials that other educators have already appraised.

**Common Core:** Ready-to-use resources for each grade level’s exemplar texts (as identified by the Common Core ELA Appendix B) are available through Reading List Resources, or directly at: <http://TeachingBooks.net/ReadingListResources>.
