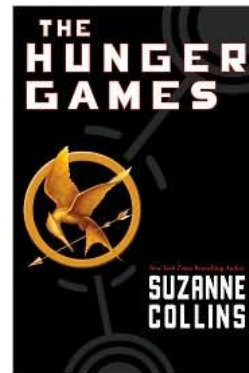
Tangled, by Carolyn Mackler

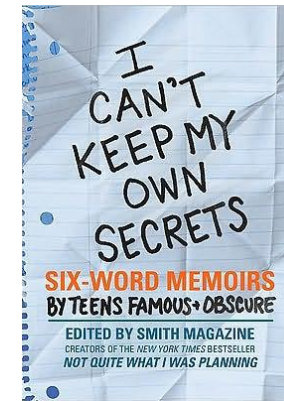

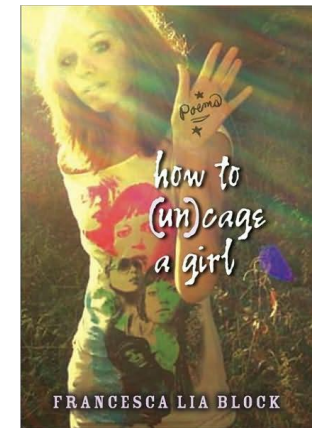


The Hunger Games, by Suzanne Collins
