

Math Vocabulary Bingo

Give each student a blank bingo card. Read a list of 24 words (you can also provide a list of words) and ask students to write a word in each square. They can write the word wherever they want. After students have completed their bingo cards, it's time to play! Read a definition and have students place a chip on the correct word on their card. Students yell bingo when they have a row horizontally, diagonally, or vertically.

Variations:

- Show a picture to illustrate the word or phrase and have students cover the correct word.
- Have students create clues for a bingo game based on a unit they are studying in class. This could be a homework assignment.
- Have students work with a partner and use math dictionary, or glossary to come up with words and clues.
- Partner Bingo- Two students work together with one bingo card. The game plays the same. When a pair has bingo, they must work together to give the meaning of each word in order.
- Special Bingo
 - Right Angle Bingo: form a right angle to win
 - Parallel Bingo
 - Perpendicular Bingo
 - Triangle Bingo
