Read aloud the items in order. Check off each item after your student has finished it.

- _____ Go to Internet Explorer.
- _____ Use the pull down menu for Favorites.
- _____ Click on the efieldtrips link.
- _____ Read the first page.
- _____ Click on Virtual Visit.
- _____ Complete the information.
 - Type in your *first name*.
 - Type in your *school name* – Whittier.
 - Type in your *city* – Long Beach.
 - Type in your *state* – CA.
 - Type in your password – sierra.
- _____ Click on the box, Enter the Virtual Tour.
- _____ Read the next screen aloud and wait for it to load.
- _____ Hand out an eTrip Journal and a pencil.
- _____ Be sure to read all the screens and wait for it to load. This is where you will find the information for your eTrip Journal.
- _____ Use the arrows to go forward and backward.
- _____ Remember to click on the links on each page.
- _____ Farther along on the eFieldTrip there will be some questions to answer.
