**Lead Story \_\_\_\_\_/10**

**Secondary Story \_\_\_\_\_/10**

- You choose the topic for this story but be sure to stay true to the events in the book.
- Story should be between 100-300 words.
- Be sure to answer who, what, when, where, why, and how.

**Opinion Story \_\_\_\_\_/5**

- Choose one theme or character from your book.
- Write a story that describes the theme or character.
- Explains how the character or theme adds to the overall message of your book.

**Pictures/Caption \_\_\_\_\_/10**

- Newsletter should have at least **two** pictures appropriate to your story.
- Caption for the picture must be relevant to the story.

**Spelling Grammar Punctuation \_\_\_\_\_/5**

- Newsletter should be free of **all** spelling errors.
- Newsletter should have correct grammar (subject verb agreement)
- Newsletter should have proper punctuation (capitalization, commas, end marks)

**Evidence of Rough Draft \_\_\_\_\_/5**

- Need to show proof of outlining ideas **before** working.
- Must turn in a rough draft with any corrections.
