

Say Something

The rules:

1. The stronger student speaks first (you decide who is feeling more confident today)
2. When you say something, you may do one of the following :
 - a. make a prediction
 - b. ask a question
 - c. make a comment
 - d. make a connection
3. If you can't do one of those four things, then you need to reread.

When you do your « Say Something», there are four things you can say.

1. **You can predict what might happen next.** For example :
« I believe that... »
« I think that... »
2. **You can ask a question.**
« What does _____ mean ? »
« Why does he say _____ ? »
3. **You can make a comment.** It can be what you like or don't like, what you don't understand, what you think is interesting, or what you think about what is happening.
« I think that Ben is a liar! »
« I don't like that Ben is selfish! »
« I don't know why _____. »
4. **Finally, you can make a connection.**
« That makes me think about *Poor Ann!* »
« I remember when.... »
« I also love big breakfasts! »
