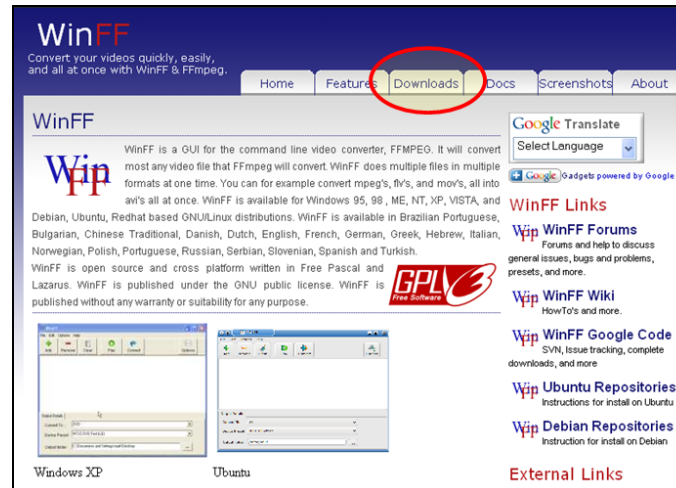


How to Download WinFF (a free video converter)

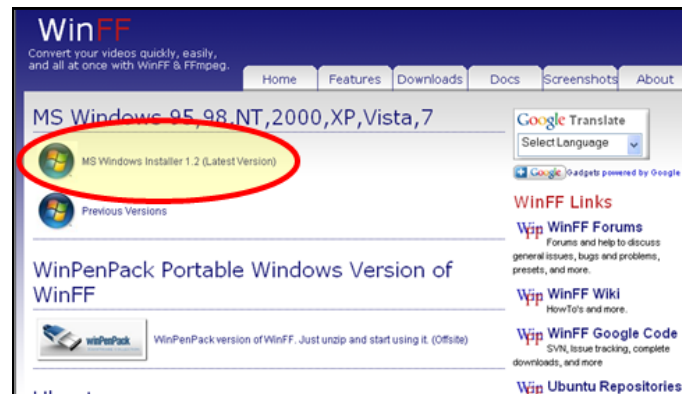
1. Navigate to the following website: http://winff.org/html_new/

2. You should now be on the WinFF website (as shown in the image to the right.)

3. From the menu tabs located on the top of the page, click on the “Downloads” tab (as shown in the image to the right.)



4. On this page, you will need to click on the “Ms Windows Installer (1.2 latest version)” (as shown in the image to the right.)

If for some reason you are unable to access the website listed in step #1, below is a list other possible links to try in order to access the free download option for WinFF.

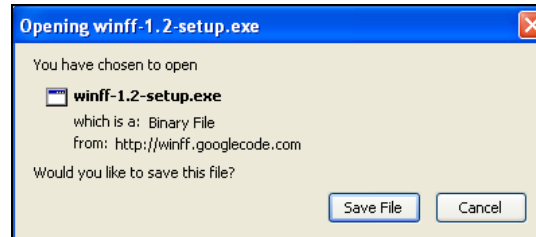

If you are unable to download WinFF yourself and/or do not have Administrative rights to download software onto your computer, then please call the help desk for assistance.

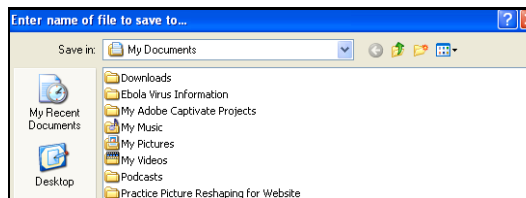

5. Next, the “Opening winff-1.2 setup.exe” dialogue box will appear. Click on “Save File.”



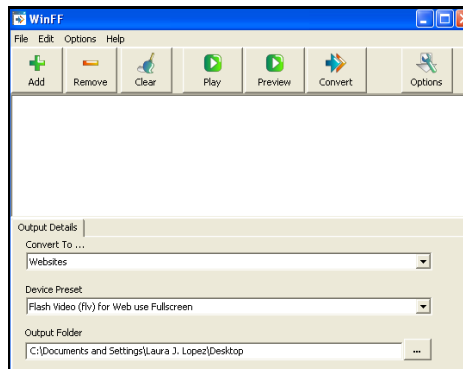
6. The “Enter name of file to save to...” dialogue box will appear. Decide and select where you would like to save to. (Note: My Documents is standard.)



7. Download is complete. You should see a the WinFF icon on your desktop (see image to the right.) Double-click on the icon to begin using WinFF.



8. When the program opens up, you should get a page that looks like the picture to the right.
