

## WORKSHEET 2-K

The **VC/CV Syllabication Rule** says that if two or more consonants stand between two vowels, divide between the \_\_\_\_\_. The first vowel will usually have a \_\_\_\_\_ sound because it will be in a \_\_\_\_\_ syllable.

If more than two consonants stand between the two vowels, divide between the consonants, keeping consonant blends (*tr*, *dr*, *nd*, etc.) and digraphs (*th*, *ch*, *sh*, *wh*) together. Circle the blends and digraphs. Divide these words into syllables and pronounce them.
