## ESL D ATTITUDE ASSIGNMENT

### 1. ***Choose a song about attitude***

- Select a song that explores attitude. It can be a song that inspires you or it can be a song with a message about attitude that is different from your own.
- The song can be in English, or you can choose a song from your first language and translate it into English.
- Print the lyrics of the song and show it to Ms. Mauer to make sure it is really about attitude.

### 2. ***Make a poster to illustrate your song***

- Create a poster to inspire other teenagers in the class.
- Find one or two lines from the song that you believe are meaningful.
- Select an illustration or several symbols that you think create an image that suits the song.
- Use colours and style of type (font) that would appeal to your audience.
- Use poster paper and materials in class to complete your poster.

### 3. ***Present your poster and song to the class. MAXIMUM TIME: 5 minutes***

- Practice reading the lyrics (words) to the song out loud. If you do not know how to pronounce all the words, listen to the song carefully and/or ask for help.
- You do not have to read the whole song – check with your teacher to see how much is enough.
- On presentation day, you will read SOME of the lyrics and explain your poster to the rest of class.

### 4. ***Write a two paragraph reflection on your project***

- Paragraph one: In your own words, describe what the song means and why it is meaningful to you.
- Paragraph two: Explain your poster. Why did you choose the words, images and other design features that you did.
