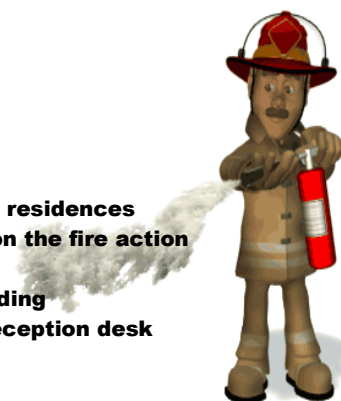


# Health & Safety: We're All Responsible

## FIRE SAFETY – PREVENTION & ADVICE

- Smoking is prohibited in halls
- Cooking is prohibited in all student bedrooms
- Please do not prop open fire doors
- Never tamper with fire extinguishers or smoke detectors
- Operate appliances as per instruction provided
- The use of candles, incense sticks and “hookah pipes” are forbidden within residences
- On hearing the evacuation alarm, evacuate the building as per instruction on the fire action notice on the back of your bedroom door
- On discovery of a fire, activate the nearest call point and evacuate the building
- If an extinguisher or a fire blanket is used for any reason, please contact reception desk immediately.

## ELECTRICAL SAFETY

- The electrical supply in the UK is 240 Volts.
- Portable fan or oil heaters not issued by housekeeping is strictly prohibited within the residences at any time
- All residences are responsible to ensure that their own electrical equipment is electronically safe i.e. correctly wired and fused and separately plugged
- All resident personal electrical equipment including plugs and adaptors must be conform to the appropriate British standards with the CE mark
- Do not use more than one adaptor or fused trailing socket or any mains wall socket in the residences
- Any equipment requiring a thirteen amp electrical supply must not be used in bedrooms. This will overload the socket and fuses will blow
- Shuko plugs are not permitted.

## FIRE ALARM TESTING

- The fire alarm systems are tested weekly:
  - **Every Wednesday**
- At this time the alarms will sound briefly but you do not need to evacuate the building
- Evacuate the building immediately if any alarm is activated for more than a few seconds.



## SECURITY AND FIRST AID

Imperial College takes security of their guests and staff very seriously. It is up to you to co-operate to ensure that the best practices are followed at all times

- In case of an emergency, dial **4444** or contact Security on **0207 589 1000**. Security can be contacted 24 hours a day. Alternatively, you can contact the Hall Reception - 49712
- When staying in hall, make sure you always lock your bedroom door and never leave any valuables lying around unattended
