

KETencycloMedia Student Access

What you should know:

- Each teacher is assigned a student passcode when (s)he sets up an account on KET EncycloMedia. Each teacher in the school has a unique student passcode.
- For a teacher to obtain his/her student passcode, (s)he would need to check with someone designated at Central Office with administrative access to the KET EncycloMedia site for his/her district, usually the DTC or CIO.

Setup Option A:

This is the preferred option for most elementary schools.

- The school sets up a generic student user-name and password for all students. For example, the 3C77-86Z4 passcode would be used to set up an account with something like the user-name "schoolname" and the password "learn".
- Students in the school would go to the KET EncycloMedia log-in page and type in "schoolname.student" for user-name and "learn" for the password and have access to the EncycloMedia site.

Setup Option B:

This is the preferred option for most middle and high schools.

- Each student is given the student passcode for a specific teacher, such as the 3C77-86Z4 passcode.
- They then go to the KET EncycloMedia log-in page and set up an individual account with a unique user-name and log-in they would use for the duration of their student careers.

Please note the ".student" addition in the user-name. Students will not be able to sign in without this added extension. The student logins do not allow the students to access any of the teacher areas of KET EncycloMedia. Basically, students can search the media on the site, but they can't access the My Content, Preferences, Teacher Center, Professional Development, and Help areas of the site.

Other Important Factors to Remember:

- Students only have the rights to use KET EncycloMedia at school because of KET's contract with Discovery.
- The only way students can access KET EncycloMedia at home is through the Student Center. This can only be accessed by the student if the teacher has created an assignment, quiz, or writing prompt through one of the "builders" and gives the students the access information to that assignment, quiz, etc.
