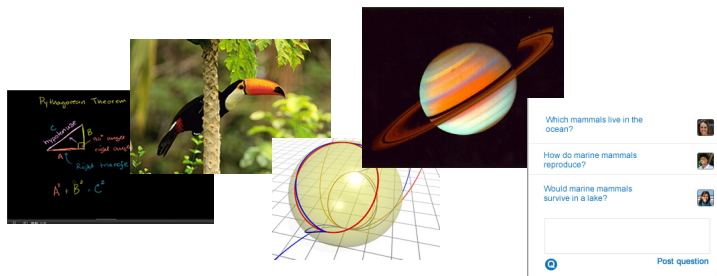
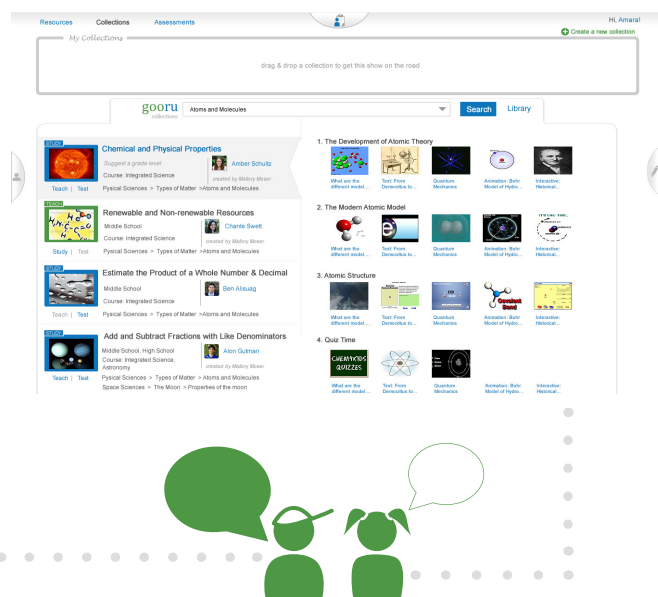
Our mission is to honor the human right to education by making high quality education free and accessible to the world's one billion students by 2013.
