THREE GRANT OPPORTUNITIES FOR 2010-2011

1. Apply for \$3,000 to continue LOMED
2. Apply for up to \$2500 of a 2:1 matching grant to work with an Educational Resource Provider (ERP)
3. Apply to participate in a new pilot. Approximately 10 congregations will have a Coalition Educator. Apply for a matching grant up to \$8,000.

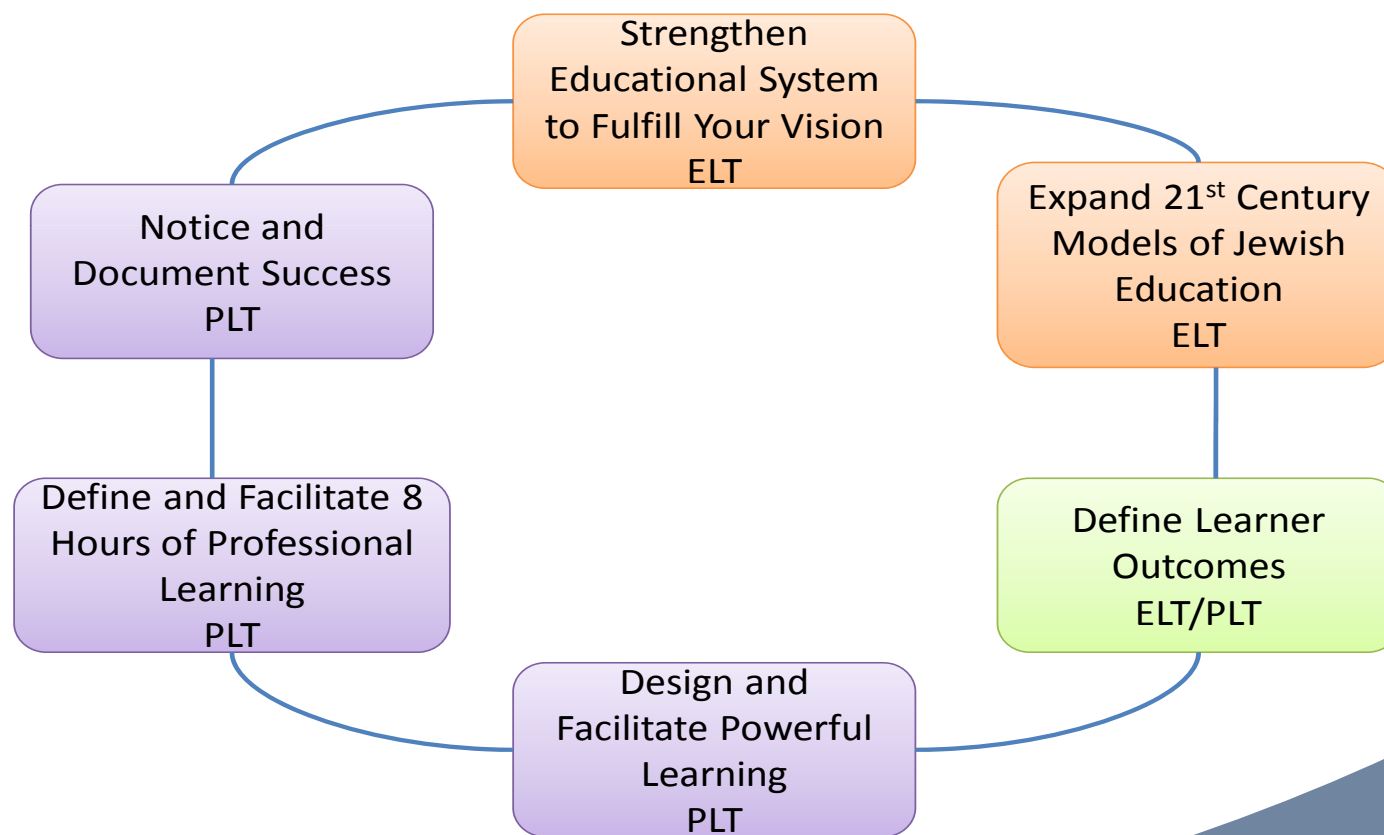
LOMED continues with three modifications:

\$7000 value

- Document and share materials and success – PLT
- Participate in LOMED gatherings – PLT and ELT
- Contract and work toward goals with your consultant — ELT
- Design and facilitate at least 8 hours of professional learning – PLT

- Leaders strengthen their resource network

GRANT OPPORTUNITY THREE: COALITION EDUCATOR PILOT

Congregations that receive LOMED and ERP grants can also apply to participate in the Coalition Educator pilot.



*Approximately 10 congregations
will pilot the role of a Coalition Educator.*



WHO ARE COALITION EDUCATORS AND WHAT DO THEY DO?

Coalition Educators will bring:

- Experience in varieties of educational settings (e.g. camp, Israel, classroom)
- An M.Ed or similar



Coalition Educators will:

- Co-plan and co-implement professional learning
- Strengthen professional learning teams
- Work with educational leadership teams to reach their goals and expand new models for Jewish education
- Link the congregation to the broad network of resources (*Educational Resource Providers, other congregations, colleagues, best practices, and more*)



HOW A COALITION EDUCATOR STRENGTHENS YOU AND THE COALITION

- Each region will employ one Coalition Educator to work with 3 congregations
- Each participating congregation employs the Coalition Educator for 10 hours per week
- Coalition Educators are full-time employees with benefits
- Coalition Educators will receive extensive training, support, and supervision from BJENY-SAJES, ECE, and Leadership Institute
