Educational Leadership Team (ELT)

Professional Learning Team (PLT)

Receive personalized support for your educational and organizational innovation. A trained LOMED consultant works with your congregation up to 6 hours each month, a \$7,000 value. Your consultant will meet with you to set your calendar and goals for the 2010-2011 year.

December 2010 and March 2011

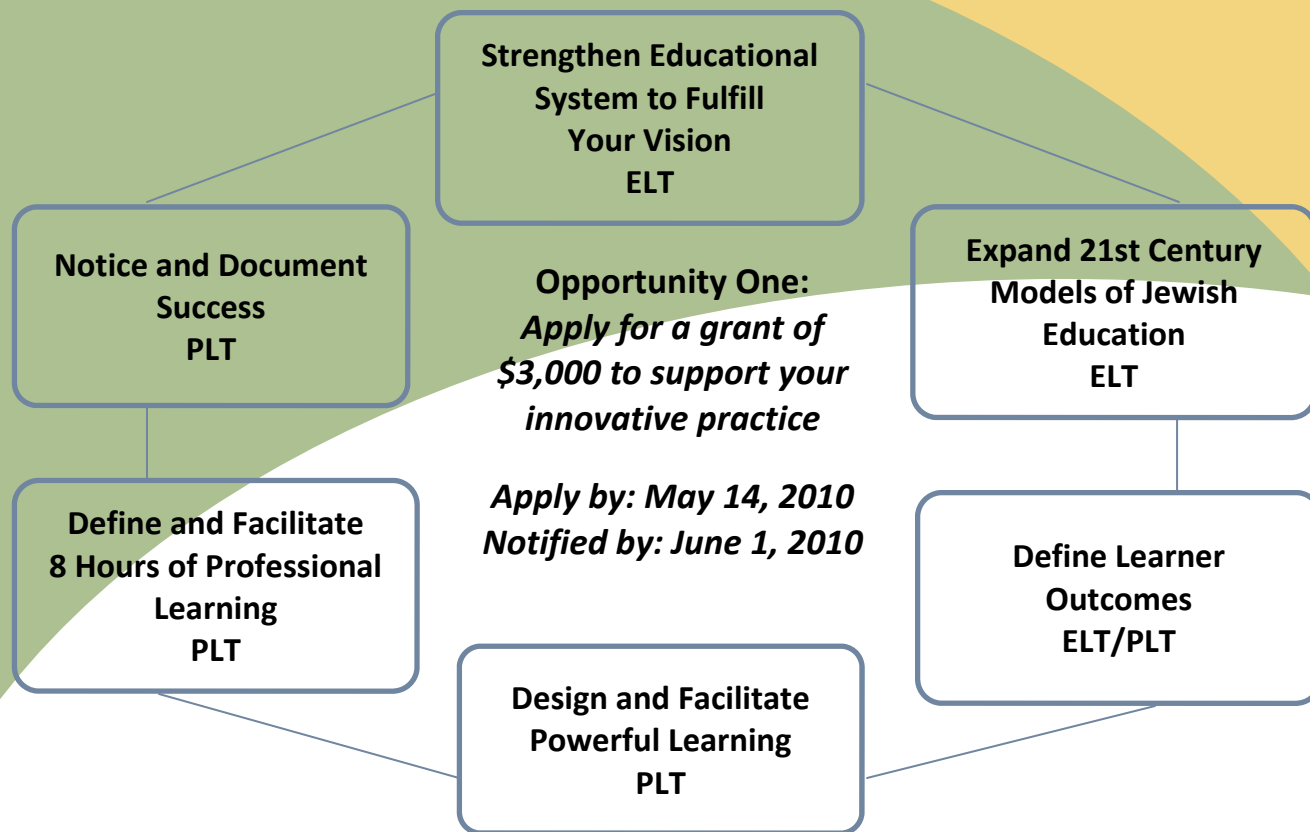

Customize LOMED: You can apply for two additional grants.

Opportunity Two: Educational Resource Provider

- Apply for up to \$2500 for a 2:1 matching grant to work with an Educational Resource Provider
- Congregations may share resources
- Select from a panel of ten ERPs (available June 1)
- Support your 8 hours of professional learning and/or teachers creating powerful learning

Apply by: June 25, 2010
Notified by: July 15, 2010

Opportunity Three: Coalition Educator

Apply for a Coalition Educator to work 10 hours per week in your congregation to:

- Co-plan and co-implement professional learning
- Strengthen Professional Learning Teams (PLT)
- Work to expand 21st Century models
- Link to the broad network of educational resources

Recipients of the first two grants may apply for this \$8000 matching grant by May 14, 2010.
