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## Rules of behaviour for during the exchange

The point of this exchange is to ensure that, once again, you spend time with and communicate with your Spanish guest. It is of course natural that you will fall back into speaking Dutch every now and then – please try to keep this to a minimum. There is also the chance that you will want to spend time with other students from your class, no problem, but include your Spanish guests at all times. It would be a shame to waste this fantastic opportunity. Therefore the following rules will apply during the week.

- During the programme at school (on Wednesday and Monday) the normal rules apply:
  - no food/drink in the classrooms
  - no jackets/caps
  - if your teacher (Spanish or Dutch) is speaking then you are quiet
  - tidy up the classroom before you leave.
- During the organized activities:
  - **Always** form mixed groups (so Spanish and Dutch students).
  - no food/drink during tours or museum visits(so also no chewing gum).
  - take into account other visitors (on your best behaviour).
  - tidy up any mess after yourselves.
  - follow any instructions given by tour leaders etc.
- In the bus:
  - A Dutch student will **always** sit next to a Spanish student.
  - No chewing gum.
  - Only water.
  - Tidy up any mess after yourselves.
- During the whole programme mobile phones will be switched off and iPods are not allowed. If you are listening to music then you can't talk to the other students or hear instructions.
- It is completely forbidden to smoke, use drugs, or alcohol.

- If there are any problem please get in touch with one of the teachers immediately. Do not phone parents as they will be worried and we are the ones with you and so can help!!!

## **Tips for during you Spanish guest's stay.**

Throughout this part of the exchange you are the host/hostess of your Spanish guest. This means that you must behave as one, but what does that mean?

Some tips:

- Explain as much as you can on Tuesday evening the following: Where he/she is going to sleep, where and what time you eat, where they can bathe/shower, where the toilet is etc.
- Involve your guest as much as possible in your family's daily routine.
- Check regularly that everything is well with your guest and ask if there is anything you can do/get for them.
- Involve your guest in family activities; if Dutch is spoken, try to translate it for them to ensure that they don't feel left out.
- Ensure that they are aware of any rules which may apply in your family, for example bed times, TV etc.
- Ask your guest questions, ask how things are with their family – remember you have stayed in their house so ask after family members.
- Try to do some fun/interesting things with your guest, for example play games, go for a walk, do some sport and tell them what's available to do in the area.

## **The Programme**

### **Tuesday 8 May – Arrival**

The Spanish guests will arrive at Eindhoven airport around 12:25. They will then travel by bus to Oss. They should be expected around 14:00. We will then greet them here at school and they will receive some lunch. We will then play some games to get to know each other again and you will have some time to show them round the school. We would then like your parents to come to pick you all up here at school at 16.00.

You will then take your guest home and you can prepare for the very busy week before you!!

### **Wednesday 9 May – Science project & Treasure hunt**

Today you will bring your pencil case, paper and a packed lunch. Don't forget to prepare a lunch for your guest. Please take into account that the Spanish students are used to having a warm lunch and may not be used to creating their own packed lunch, help them with this. Check that they have got enough and maybe organize a few extras. Some things such as a cheese slicer and 'hagelslag' may be new for them.

You are expected at 8:30 at room 014. We will be working on our science project, preparing the debates. This will continue until 12:40. Break will be at the normal time 10:20 – 10:40. Take your guest to where you usually go at the break.

From 12:40 to 13:10 you will have lunch break. By 13:15 at the latest you will come together outside the 160 building. In four groups we will go into Oss for a treasure hunt. Who knows? Maybe you will learn some things you never knew about Oss. The programme finishes around 15.00 .

The rest of the afternoon and evening are free.

### **Thursday 10 May – Amsterdam: Interactive Nemo science & Anne Frank museums**

Today you will once again require a packed lunch for yourself and your guest. Make sure you bring enough as you will be back late.

You are expected at 8:00 at the swimming pool car park. We will then leave by bus for Amsterdam.

From 10:30 until around 12:45 we will be visiting the interactive Nemo science museum . Please remember we are visitors and act accordingly. While the museum is interactive this does not mean you can do as you like, there are of course the rules of the museum.



After our visit we will make our way to Dam square. At 13:00 you will be given some free time to have your lunch and if you wish to do some shopping. Please remain with your Spanish guests at all times. They are new to the city and can not speak the language and so it is up to you to care for them.

You are once again expected at Dam Square at 15.30. From here we will make our way to the Anne Frank museum. In the Anne Frank museum we will be split up into 2 groups. We will be led through the museum in the two groups.



At around 17:30 we will make our way back to the bus; we will then leave Amsterdam at around 18.00. Depending on the traffic situation we expect to arrive in Oss at roughly 20.00.

Please remember to arrange something to eat for when you arrive home as you will not yet have eaten!

### **Friday 11 May – Efteling Amusement Park**

Today you will need a packed lunch for yourself and your Spanish guest. Take extra snacks for while you are waiting in line. You are expected at the swimming pool car park at 9:30. We will be leaving for the Efteling at 9:45.

Once again you are expected to make mixed groups of Dutch/Spanish students and please be on hand to translate and explain some of the rides.



We will meet up again at the entrance of the Efteling at 15:00 to make our way back to Oss. We expect to be back around 16:30.

## **Saturday 12 May – Family Morning & Canoeing in the afternoon (to be confirmed)**

Today you will have a free morning to give you a chance to take part in your sports clubs. Take your Spanish guest with you and perhaps they could join in?

At 13:00 you are expected at the swimming pool car park where we will get the bus to Nijmegen. We are going to take part in some canoeing. Bring extra (warm) clothes and shoes just in case as well as a rain jacket.

## **Monday 14 May – Science Project, Concentration camp Kamp Vught, Discotheque**

Today is school day so please remember to bring everything you need. You are expected in room 014 at 8:30. There we will do the finishing touches to the debates and we will then present them to the other groups.

At 13:00 we will go to the bus where we will then drive to Kamp Vught. In three groups we will be led through the Kamp. Please remember where you are and show respect accordingly. Rules of the Kamp are as follows;

No shouting No running No laughing No eating/drinking outside the appropriate areas

At 16:30 we will return to the bus to return to Oss and depending on the traffic should be back by 17:15.

At 19.30 you are cordially invited to attend the biggest event of the year!! The disco at discotheque Bobz in Nistelrode. You and your parents will have created some delicious nibbles for us to keep up our energy for all that dancing!!



The party is until 23:00.
