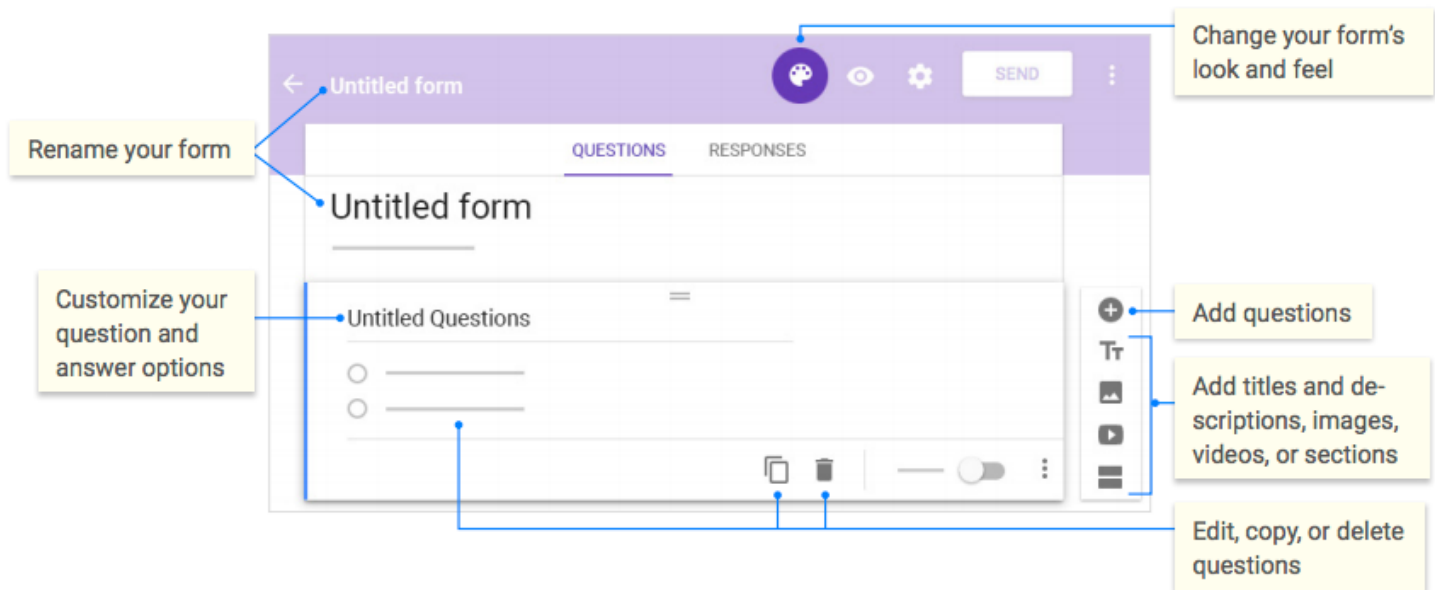




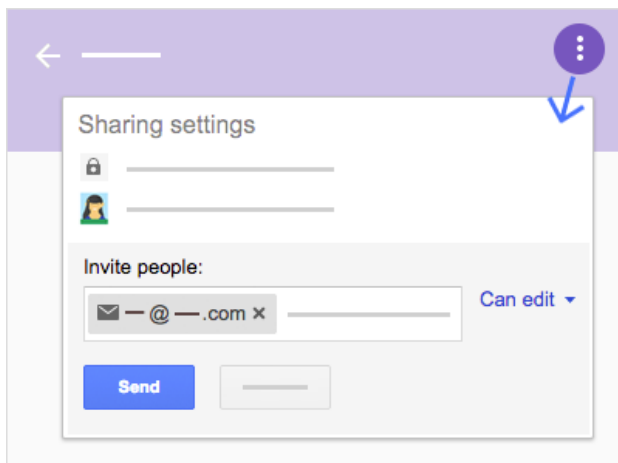

Manage event registrations, whip up a quick opinion poll, create a pop quiz, and much more.

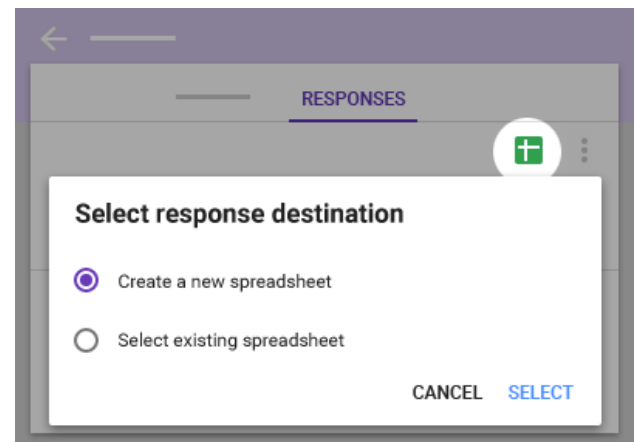
1 Build your form.
