

NON-DISCRIMINATION ON THE BASIS OF DISABILITY FOR ALL STUDENTS

The Loudoun County School Board does not discriminate against students on the basis of disability. The purposes of this policy ~~are~~ is to communicate the requirements of provide an avenue for the resolution of complaints with respect to any alleged discrimination on the basis of disability as provided by Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended, and the Americans with Disabilities Act ("ADA"). This policy provides an avenue for the prompt and equitable resolution of complaints with respect to any alleged discrimination against students on the basis of disability, including ~~and with respect to~~ the identification, evaluation, and educational placement of eligible school-aged students.

No otherwise qualified disabled ~~person~~ student shall, solely by reason of disability, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or otherwise be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity ~~which receives or benefits from federal financial assistance offered by the school division. For purposes of this policy, a qualified disabled person shall be one who satisfies the definition set forth in the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended, and its implementing regulations.~~

~~The Director of Diagnostic and Prevention Services is designated as Coordinator for the implementation of this policy.~~

The Division Superintendent shall adopt regulations to implement this policy as follows: Regulation 8040-1 applies to eligible preschool, elementary, and secondary students; and Regulation 8040-2 applies to students enrolled in an Adult Education Program.
