

Complete a summary of your scrapbook / media file. Use the following headings as a guide to complete the summary:

CONTEXT

Choose a focus question or create your own for your research. This question should be broad enough to enable you to research and analyse information, but narrow enough that you can find an answer. It should focus on one area of the topic that particularly interests you.

Answer the following:

- Why did you choose or accept this topic?
- What was one thing you knew about this topic before you started?
- What experience have you had in this area?

EXPERIENCE

Research the topic. Look at the resources you have collected that relate to your focus question. Your resources should come from a range of sources and locations.

Answer the following:

- Where did you find most of your resources?
- What was the hardest item to find?
- How long did it take you to find all the resources necessary?
- What did you find the most interesting part of your research? Why was this?
- At what point was your knowledge, ideas or opinions challenged while doing this topic?

REFLECTION

Create a summary of your resources, focusing on the facts (who, what, when, where, how and why) that relate to your focus question.

Answer the following:

- Write a summary of what you have learnt about your topic.
- Describe a person or program you have met in relation to your task that you admire or think is good. Explain why.
- In what way could what I have learnt in my topic make a difference to the world?

ACTION

Answer your focus question. Your response may be composed in the form of an essay, a flow chart, annotated diagram, song, artwork, poem (minimum 20 lines), web page, or another mode of presentation that you **negotiate with your teacher**.

Once you have completed your "answer" in the form of your choice;

Answer the following:

- Explain what you have learned as a result of your research and reflection.
- Discuss how your views about your chosen topic have been changed or affirmed.
- What value or point of view of yours has been changed by this task and your findings?
- In what way could what you have learnt make a difference to how you or your peers think or behave?

EVALUATION

Answer the following:

In what way has your learning on this topic helped you to appreciate something in another subject at school (Senior Science, Food Tech, PDHPE etc)?

How has this task changed your idea of or relationship with God?

Identify an area of your topic that you have more questions about. Give an example of such questions.

This should take approximately 750 – 1000 words. (This should be part of / within your scrapbook / mediafile)
