

This will be a **minimum of 1300 words** and a **maximum of 1500 words** (not including tables and graphs). You are **encouraged** to use **subheadings** to help the structure of your written response. Include up to date economic indicators (statistics).

## **PART TWO – GROUP WORK (group of two).**

*As a group, present an outline (presentation of the above) to say **how Australia and your developing country differ**. Make some **recommendations** on how the developing nation you have chosen can **improve its economic growth and development**.*

Your group **will give a presentation to the class** on the two economies both Australia and your developing economy and **say clearly “How They Differ”**. You may use the same headings as in the written task that you hand in as an individual piece of work.

You will have to **work together** on a **solution(s) to the developing country’s economic problems**. As a group, you are going to work out a **set of recommendations** for the **developing economy to help its economy grow (how to increase employment, increase output, and quality of life and so on)**. Also you will need to find (as a team or group) other sources for your basic information and economic indicators (‘two heads are better than one’). Your task is to gather information and report your findings in a simple way to say ‘How Economies Differ’ (Australia and a relatively poor developing economy of your choice). Gather information and report your findings to the class.
