- . mentions some facts about personal background of the queen
- . explores two to three roles of the queen with adequate discussion
- . indicates limited historical/archaeological evidence to support roles performed by the queen

(1-2 MARKS)

- . does not mention the personal background of the queen
- . limited listing of some roles of the queen with inadequate discussion or none at all
- . does not present historical/archaeological evidence to support roles performed by the queen

IV. AKHENATEN – FIRST INDIVIDUAL OR A REBEL PHARAOH ;  
RAMESSESS – GREAT OR PROPAGANDIST (5 marks)

- . defines the terms according to the personality studied – individual, rebel, great, propagandist
- . connects the terminology to the specific actions, events of the personality and provides a comprehensive discussion and analysis of the linkage among them
- . indicates historical/archaeological evidence to support their points of view

(3-4 MARKS)

- . defines some of the terms
- . uses the terminology and gives some actions, events of the personality as examples
- . indicates a few historical/archaeological evidence to support their points of view

(1-2 MARKS)

- . fails to define most of the terms
- . uses some of the terminology and gives limited actions, events of the personality but linkage is not clear
- . does not present historical/archaeological evidence to support their points of view

V. ADAPTATION TO THE CHANGING WORLD IN WHICH THE  
HITTITES, MITANNI, OTHER ENEMIES OF EGYPT PRESENTED AS  
POSSIBLE THREATS (5 MARKS)

- . identifies the geography and extend of Hittite, Mitanni and other powers control and influence
- . identifies and provides a discussion and analysis of its impact on Egypt and its empire or sphere of influence
