. explains and provides an analysis of Akhenaten's battle with the Amun priesthood

. discusses the effects and consequences of this battle on the protagonists and Egypt as a whole

. identifies and explains reasons why it was a victory, a defeat or both; short range to long range points of view

(3-4 MARKS)

. explains Akhenaten's battle with the Amun priesthood

. mentions some effects and consequences of this battle on either Akhenaten, Amun priesthood or Egypt

. points out why it was a victory or defeat or both

(1-2 MARKS)

. mentions Akhenaten's battle with the Amun priesthood

. lists some effects and consequences of the battle

VIII. RAMESSESS II RELATIONSHIP WITH THE GODS (5 MARKS)

. provides the connection with the religious situation in Egypt pre- Amarna and Amarna

. explains and provides an analysis of Ramessess II's relationship with Amun and the other other gods and goddesses

. provides a discussion of the effects of such a religious policy with historical/archaeological evidence
