

Task 3- Multimedia- Power point presentation- Oral and hand in- 10 marks

All seven information processes are involved in the development of multimedia. Many of the tasks involve a combination of processes. The development of a multimedia product emphasises the following information processes:

- Collecting- data is gathered in text, audio, video and graphic formats.
